Pol-Aurélien Cathedral SAINT-POL-DE-LÉON Location on the map : D4	The cathedral was built on the ruins of a roman cathedral from the 12th century and reflects the Gothic style. It possesses a remarkable nave from the 13th century made of limestone from Caen, an ensemble almost unique in Brittany, a choir made of granite dating to the 15th century and a 17-century organ built by the englishmen Robert Dallam and his son, Thomas.
