<b>Pol-Aurélien Cathedral</b> SAINT-POL-DE-LÉON Location on the map : D4	The cathedral was built on the ruins of a roman cathedral from the 12th century and reflects the Gothic style. It possesses a remarkable nave from the 13th century made of limestone from Caen, an ensemble almost unique in Brittany, a choir made of granite dating to the 15th century and a 17th-century organ built by the englishmen Robert Dallam and his son, Thomas.  9am- 6pm. 5 - 30 July : everyday, 10.30am - 1pm & 3pm - 6.30pm (except Saturday, Sunday morning and tuesdays between 11am and 12pm) : free guided tours (in french only).	Free entrance.
<b>Notre-Dame-du-Kreisker Chapel</b> SAINT-POL-DE-LÉON Location on the map : D4	The 14th-15th-century chapel has the tallest spire (80m-high) of Brittany and was built by an english architect !  Open from 10.30am to 6pm during french school holidays (zone B). 15 July - 15 August : exhibition "Céleste" with the artist Brigitte Prieur.	Free entrance.
<b>Walking and cycling trails</b> SAINT-POL-DE-LÉON	<b>Heritage trail</b> : Walk and discover our town centre and coastline with 28 interpretative signs layed out throughout the different trails. <b>Sainte-Anne Islet</b> : natural area linked to the mainland by The promenade de Penarth. <b>Saint-Pol-de-Léon - Roscoff</b> : A pleasant walk of 8km on foot, following the GR34 coastal trail. <b>Bike trail</b> : Follow the green trail.
